

10 THINGS

To remember for your exams

- 1 Bring your student ID card**
If you need another one, organise this through Student Administration Services (fee applies)
- 2 What additional resources are you allowed in the exam?**
Your unit coordinator should tell you this ahead of the exam – perhaps a calculator or a text book. If you're not sure, check with them now.
- 3 Bring your pens and pencils**
These are not supplied and you cannot borrow during the exam. Carry them in a clear plastic container.
- 4 No mobiles, smart watches or devices**
They need to be switched off and left outside or with the exam supervisors at the front of the venue.
- 5 No food or drink**
Only water in a clear container is permitted in the exam venue.
- 6 Check the exam timetable carefully before your exam**
Keep checking your timetable up to the date of the exam as times/venue may change.
- 7 Don't bring bags and personal items**
These need to be left outside of the exam venue.
- 8 Get there on time – plan your travel!**
Plan to arrive at least 15 minutes before your exam.
- 9 No caps or hats**
Please leave these outside the exam venue – including motorcycle or bicycle helmets.
- 10 In case of emergency**
Make sure your mobile number is current in Student Connect in case we need to contact you.
